

Euthanasia Policy

We will make every effort to maintain or bring a good quality of life to each and every animal that comes into the Sanctuary. No animal will ever be euthanized due to cost, space or age. Even when an animal exhibits aggressive behavior, all efforts will be made to protect both the animal and all living beings at the Sanctuary.

Euthanasia will only be considered when quality of life is no longer obtainable. Due to irremediable suffering and/or after consultation with our veterinarian that there is no chance of recovery. We have a duty to do what is best for the animals in our care, as difficult as that may be.

When it is deemed necessary to execute that difficult decision, only the utmost humane method will be used and administered by a veterinarian.
